MOBILE VAN CLINICS



The new DHB contract requires a target of approximately 2,300 women who are over 30 years of age and not had a cervical smear test in the last five years or due a one year recall.

This is a challenge for WONS which has resulted in an increased investment in mobile nurse smear clinics in the community. WONS has also purchased our own mobile van which is now fully operational.

Increasing the nurse smear taker capacity of WONS has also been a priority to ensure we can reach the target. Although challenging the work has been very rewarding with women utilising the van well! A calendar for each month's mobile van is on www.wons.org.nz.
